

## English

We will be learning the 'Little Red Riding Hood' story in a 'talk for writing' style. Then children will create their own version of the story by changing the setting. We will be writing factual information about Australian animals. The children will be continuing to work on their own personal writing targets. We will further develop their phonics skills, punctuation and spellings.

## Mathematics

In mathematics we will be continuing to work on our number bonds. We will be spending more time practising addition and taking away using maths games. We will also be using arrays for division and multiplication. The children will also be continuing to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will tell the time and use coins to solve word problems.

## Science

This term we will be learning about the human body, labelling the key parts and using our senses. We will be learning about different habitats: native woodland, Australian outback and pond-life. We will be pond dipping at the Waterworks Museum, using the wildlife garden and visiting Queenswood.

Music: Peter and the wolf

Spanish: colours, phrases and cooking paella.

Computing: book creator, Beebots and Scratch Jr programs..

## History and Geography

Y1 will be using time lines and finding out about Queen Victoria, Elizabeth II, Captain Cook and Victorian schools. We will turn our classrooms into a Victorian style classroom. After half term we will be learning about Australia: location, climate, wildlife, and Art, culture and time difference.

## Enrichment Activities
