Make your own globe and mark on the equator.
Write a description of the weather in winter using interesting adjectives.	Create your own money rub picture using different coins. (rub the front of a coin using a crayon and paper)	Can you write a list of PE games that can be played at playtimes and lunchtimes? How will these be safe?	What countries are near the equator? What is the hottest country in the world?	Create a collage of your choice of weather scene; Snow Rain Sun
