Create a board game with a rainforest theme.
Write a persuasive letter to the Brazilian government about your view on deforestation.	Roll a die to create numbers to practise long multiplication and short division.	Create a team game that your class could play.	Research and write up the life cycle of a rainforest animal of your choice.	Use a range of different materials to create a rainforest scene.
Create a fact file on the different plants which are found in the different layers in the rainforest.	Design your dream house using your knowledge of area and perimeter.	Write a review of a sporting event you have seen (this could be an event on the television).	Create a homemade lava lamp and write up what you notice.	Draw a rainforest animal which lives in each layer.
Write a kenning on a rainforest animal (for us to guess!)	Create a maths quiz that covers the topics we have learnt this term (Fractions/Decimals /Percentages, Measurement, Number, Geometry, Multiplication)	Research a sporting personality and write a short biography including their achievements.
