Here are some topics which you can work from at home. All work can be recorded in a way that you choose.

Imagine you are a character in a Magic Key story. The Magic Key takes you to another world – what can you see, feel and hear there?	Create your own shop with items from around the house. Can you label how much things might cost? Can you name them?	Create a board game that you can play with your family. Don't forget to write down the rules.
Using bullet points, make a list of objects you would need if you were going on a Summer holiday.	Gather some real money from your family. Can you use this money to pay for items from your shop?	Time how long you can jog on the spot for. Can you beat it the next day? Count the seconds in your head or out loud.	Create a suitable habitat for minibeasts e.g. similar to the insect hotel we have in the eco garden at school.	Play a game of charades with your family.
Write a poem about the Arctic. Think about what a poem looks like, and remember that it does not have to rhyme.	Using different objects from around your house, measure how long or tall they are using your hands or feet. Are there any other ways you can measure them?	Design a new PE kit for the school. Think about what colours we could use and if it is suitable for indoor and outdoor activities.	If you can, get a group of ice cubes. Put them in different places around the house and see which one melts the quickest. Why do you think this happened?	Create your own minibeast, labelling the different parts and giving it a name.
Research Sir James Clark Ross. Why is he famous? Tell me as many facts as you can about him.	Write the numbers to 100 using words. How far can you get?	Create a Spring dance. Can you find some music that would go with the Spring theme?	Thinking about the ice cube experiment, can you change anything to make the ice melt slower e.g. size or temperature.	See how well you can remember the school – can you create a map of the school and grounds with labels?

Please continue to support your child's learning by reading daily and using the phonics folders, as well as practising their spelling words and putting them into sentences on the back of the sheet.
