Here are some topics which you can work from at home. All work can be recorded in a way you choose.

Describe an African Animal (Giraffe, Meerkat or Parrot).	Create your own number bond to 10/20 board game. Can you teach your parents to play?	Design a den and make it in your bedroom or garden.	What different materials can you find around the house?	Design your own outfit for a holiday to Africa – make sure it is appropriate for Africa weather.
Create a leaflet to advertise an imaginary place! Design your own castle, island, enchanted forest, or anywhere you fancy!	Look for symmetry and tessellation in real life. Have a go at creating your own pictures.	Can you create a game using direction (forward, backward, left, right, quarter/half turn)?	Which materials in your house, are waterproof? E.g., tin foil, toilet roll etc.	Can you make and play your own African drums?
Create a fact file about Africa	Zoe has 20 stickers. She gives three of them to her friend. How many stickers does she have left? Draw this. Can you make up some word problems of your own using the four rules.	Research if there are any traditional African dances. Can you perform one?	Why is recycling important? What can we recycle? Be the recycling police in your house and create a diary of everything that is recycled in your house in a week.	What will you pack in your rucksack to go on an adventure trail? Why?
Write a postcard pretending you are in Africa. What is it like? What have you seen?	Help out with the cooking. Use scales to measure out ingredients.	Create an assault course that uses different skills and see how quickly you can complete it.	What materials would you use for a warm and waterproof coat in the winter? Design this coat and label it.	Design a flag for your perfect country.
