You need to have the answers ready! Can they get 10/10? For example: How many feet is your garden all the way around? Challenge: Think of something unusual to measure your garden with. Suddenly, the dragonfly extended its elegant wings.</p>	<p>Subtraction Questions Create 10 three-digit subtraction questions that your family could answer? You need to have the answers ready! It does not need to be in your garden, it could be on your daily walk. Challenge: Write a paragraph explaining why this is your favourite place.</p>	<p>Famous Historians Pick 5 famous people from history. Think of 5 questions you would ask them. Challenge: Can you think of your own verb(s) and adverbs to match.</p>	<p>Negative Numbers Write a number line from 20 to -20. Can you come up with a game using your number line? It can be as creative as you like! Ask your family to rate your game.</p>	<p>Let's Get Physical! Create a 5-minute exercise routine to complete each day for a week. (star jumps, hops, skipping, spider mans, running). Does it get easier as the days go on?</p>	<p>Iceland Research Iceland. What is it famous for? Is there more than one thing it is famous for? How does it compare to England? Why have you picked them? Why do they inspire you? Challenge: Include a drawing. This can be an illustration or a sketch.</p>
<p>Detailed Description Imagine you are visiting a circus. Write a detailed description using all five senses. Challenge: How many writing features can you include in this piece?</p>	<p>Times Tables In partners, throwing a ball or a cushion back and forth, can you recite your times table knowledge. For example: 2 ... 4 ... 6. 4 ... 8 ... 12.</p>	<p>Picture Time Can you create a picture using natural materials? E.g. leaves, sticks etc.</p>	<p>Tudor Characters Create a character from the Tudor times. What will your character be wearing? How would they live?
