Questions Write questions that you can ask your family about fairgrounds. Some examples: 'What is your favourite fairground ride and why?' 'How old were you when you first went to the fair?' 'In which month do we usually see the fair?' Don't forget that a question always ends with a question mark:	Number bond Draw ducks with number bonds to 10 or 20 inside them ready for the 'Hook a Duck' stall. Pick a duck and read out the number sentence. Does it equal 10 or 20?	Have a go at completing your obstacle course. (See creative section.) Who can do it the quickest? How many different ways can you think of to time who is the quickest? E.g. a stopwatch, counting. You can play it on any phase, so make sure you are not finding it too easy or too hard. Try the bowling activity and the circles activity with your eyes closed/using a blindfold. Does this make the activities harder? Do you notice if anything happens to your other senses when you cannot see?	Use the resources you have collected throughout the week (boxes, bottles, pebbles) and identify the materials they are made of. Are they natural or man- made?
