Here are some topics which you can work from at home. All work can be recorded in a way you choose.

English	Maths	Physical	Science	Creative
Nouns – people, places and things. Write A-Z down the side of a page. Can you think of a country for each letter?	Number bonds to 10 and 20. Google 'hit the button topmarks' then select number bonds. Play the games up to 10 then up to 20. https://www.topmarks.co .uk/maths-games/hit-the- button	Google <i>'BBC African</i> <i>drumming and dance</i> <i>sequences'</i> It will come up with a 2.09min African dance on BBC school/bite size clip. Watch it and have a go at joining in.	Where do animals live? True or false 'Polar bears eat penguins'? Explain why.	Choose a country from around the World. Research it and make a mind map of what you find out.
Adjectives – describing words. Make a poster with as many adjectives on as you can think of.	Practise counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and 3's.	Act like an animal. How do they move? Can your family guess which animal you are? Swap over.	Choose 2 countries and find out about the weather in them. How are they the same/different?	Have a go at drawing your own world map and labelling the continents of the World.
Verbs – action words. Write down as many verbs as you can think of, then act them out. Get someone to guess which verb you are acting out.	Food shopping bananas 32p apples 25p oranges 36p tomato 45p carrots 43p potatoes 28p 1) You are allowed to buy two items from the shop? How much will they cost? Use column addition. Repeat with various items. 2) You have 86p what can you buy with it and how much change would you have?	Fine motor skills. Find out what the Eiffel Tower, in Paris, France, looks like. Build your own using Lego. If you are feeling really adventurous you could use spaghetti and playdough/blue tack.	Food chains. Find out what animals eat. If it is another animal what does that animal eat etc. e.g. lion – zebra – grass. Start with 1) bear 2) fox 3) human and find out their food chains.	Flags of the world. Find out about different flags and choose your favourite and colour/paint it.
Conjunctions – words that join sentences to make them longer. Write a sentence using each of these conjunctions. and or but when if that because e.g. I went to the park and I went on the swing.	How long is 1 minute? Watch the clock and see how long it is. Then see how many times you can hop/clap/jump in 1 min. Make up some of your own ideas and record your answers.	Yoga – Cosmic Kids YouTube channel have some great yoga sessions.	Look outside/go out in the garden. What plants can you identify?	Design and make your own pizza. (You can use wraps/pitta bread as the base/or google the flour and Greek yoghurt base recipe). Add your own toppings then ask an adult to put it under the grill/in the oven.
