Make a holiday brochure for your dream holiday! Think about where you would love to go when lockdown is over.	If you can, make a cake or pizza and slice it into halves, quarters, eighths or any other fraction. Take a photo.	If you can, add some herb seeds to your parents' shopping list and grow them.	Find out about the Anglo-Saxons. Who were they and when did they come to Britain? Create a fact file about Anglo-Saxon life in Britain. Use BBC Bitesize to help you.	Build a Lego rainbow!

Ask for a plate, then add soil, grass, flowers, stones for a path etc. Could it be a home for a bug or a fairy tale creature?	Write messages in Anglo Saxon runes for someone to decode. http://www.earlybritishkingdoms.com/kids/runes.html	Look on Youtube and Pinterest and try painting with salt!
Create a spooky comic book story using just pictures. Tell it out loud to someone.	Hide numbers 1 – 20 in the garden or house. Challenge someone to find them then add them all together. What is your total?	On a sunny day put some objects outside onto paper (or the patio if you are allowed and have chalk). Draw round the shadows in the morning, lunchtime and evening. Can you see how the shadow changes?	Make a snowstorm in a jar. Can you explain why and how it works? https://onelittleproject.com/?s=snowstorm	Find out who your parents or siblings favourite band is. Who is yours? Draw and colour your own band and name them.
Find as many spooky adjectives as you can. Try and write them into sentences.	Play the Bobbie Bear game below. You can adjust the setting by using the 'custom' button. Collect some flowers and leaves, put them in between some paper and then shut them in a heavy book. In a few weeks they will be flat and dry. Can you make a picture or a bookmark with them?	Find out about habitats and food chains. What is a producer? What is a consumer? You can find all the information in the science section on BBC Bitesize. Watch the videos and challenge yourself to see if you can answer the questions.	Make a water xylophone and learn to play a tune. Again, use the internet to help you.
