


Year 1 Home Learning



Here are some topics which you can work from at home. All work can be recorded in a way you choose. The theme for this week is 'Room on the Broom' by Julia Donaldson. You can watch the BBC version of the story <u>here</u> and you can read it online <u>here</u>.

Each day we put a 'Word of the Day' on the grid below. See if you can:

- Find the definition
- Use the word in a sentence
- Practise writing this word in your neatest handwriting.
- Can you think of any other words which have a similar meaning?
- Challenge Can you draw a picture that represents the word

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

Think about what each animal would need.  *Challenge – Create a 3D model of your broomstick design.	Think about the different characters in the book: the witch, cat, dog, bird, frog and dragon. Create a 'frozen shape' for each animal. Think about what shape you would like to make with your body. With your arms and hands. What height would each animal shape be?  Now find a way of moving from one 'frozen shape' to another to create a sequence.  Movement ideas: Hopping, jumping, Walking, skipping, side stepping.



## Monday - Maths Resource 1- Fallen Off the Broom

LO: I can work out problems using my number bonds to 10.

**Task:** You need to fit **10** animals on your broom. However, during the journey, some of the animals have fallen off. How many more animals do you need to add back onto the broom to make **10**? Above the dog is the number of animals already on the broom. On the line above the witch, can you write the extra number of animals you need?



## Wednesday - Maths Resource 2 - Balancing the Broom

#### LO: I can use addition to solve a problem.

# Balancing the Broom

Each animal is worth an amount. You need to place the animals onto the broom using your addition skills. The animals need to add together to make the same amount as the witch. Which animals would you need to add to the broom? You can use the same animal or different. There are lots of different ways. How many can you find for each question?

Frog = 2

Cat = 4

Bird = 6

Fish = 5

Bat = 7

Dog = 3

Fly = 1

Hamster = 8

For example:

The Witch = 18



You could do:

Frog + Frog + Fly + Fish + Bat + Fly = 
$$18$$
  
2 + 2 + 1 + 5 + 7 + 1 =  $18$ 

Or

$$Bat + Bat + Cat = 18$$
  
7 + 7 + 4 = 18


