

## English

During this term, children will continue to explore a range of different genres including; play scripts, poetry, historical texts and balanced arguments. Using technical language within a variety of text types will continue to be developed. Spelling, grammar and punctuation will be a constant focus throughout this term. In reading, children will practice their inference and deduction skills by studying a range of texts.

## Mathematics

In mathematics this term, children will be continuing to study all aspects of arithmetic and reasoning. Children will continue to use the four rules which include formal written methods and will then apply them to demonstrate the mastery of this within a range of question types.

Children will also be solving problems involving the calculation and conversion of units of measure and will continue to practice their estimation knowledge as a tool for checking for accuracy.

## Science

As part of our living things and their habitats topic, children will be describing how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. They will also give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

## History

The children will continue to research the British Monarchy, with a key focus on the Victorians. Children will experience a day in the life of a Victorian child.

## PSHE

During this term, Sex and Relationship Education will be taught. There will be opportunities for discussion and a question and answer session.

## Religious Education

In R.E, we will begin by exploring what kind of a King Christians believe Jesus is and how that influences their behaviour.

We will then move on to thinking about how faith helps people of all religions when life gets hard.

## Physical Education

In P.E, the children will play competitive games, applying basic principle. They will also participate in Sports Day as well as HMFA athletics where they try for personal bests and compare previous performances (in line with correct Covid guidance). We will be learning all about Big Data - how it is transferred, its uses and how devices are connected via the 'Internet of things'. They will be creating spreadsheets and graphs to see how businesses analyse data and use it to make plans.

They will end the topic by designing a 'Smart School'.

## MFL

In MFL, the children will develop their reading, writing and speaking skills in Spanish through the topics of food and opinions. They will also learn the different Spanish vocabulary for animals. All of this will add to their existing conversational knowledge.
