English

Our English lessons will continue to build on story writing skills. The children will focus on suspense writing and developing their vocabulary. Spellings will continue to be taught on a weekly basis and the children will continue to develop their grammar and punctuation skills. Our Class text for Talk4Reading will be The Iron Man.

PSHE/British Values

We will continue to follow the jigsaw scheme of work which looks at 'healthy me' and 'changing me'. Alongside our rivers topics we will teach the children about river safety.

Mathematics

In mathematics we will be focusing on fractions, time and measurement. The children will continue to develop their knowledge and skills of the Four Rules and apply these skills to our topic areas. They will continue to practice their basic skills and times tables. Keep using TT Rockstars!

computing

The children will be looking at electronic music from the 1980s with Garage band.
They will also be creating databases.

DT

The children will explore different types of packaging and create their own. They will also evaluate healthy food products and prepare and cook their own healthy bar.

Science

This term the children will also be finding out about different habitats. We will be considering the positive and negative impact of humans on the environment.

Music

using Garage band, the children will explore 1980s electronic music. They will create their own pieces of music. They children will also create their own composition based on a journey down the river.

RE

In RE we will think about the type of world that Jesus wanted and which groups of people help others today. The children will look at religious festivals and why they are important to communities.

All of these skills will be taught through mini tennis, cricket and athletics.

Enrichment Activities

Linking with our RE topic we will explore Christian places of worship in Hereford including St Nicholas Church and the Christian Life Church. To conclude our history topic, we will take a trip to St Fagans Museum to explore how people lived throughout the ages. (Subject to Covid-19 restrictions)

History and Geography

Year 3 will be travelling back in time to explore the world of the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings. They will discover how life changed in Britain after the Romans left.

In geography the children will investigate the different stages of a river and how the rivers of Britain have influenced the development of travel and settlements.
