English

The children will continue to develop their spelling using the Spelling Shed, punctuation, grammar and handwriting skills. The main focus of the term will be both non-narrative and narrative. The children will be looking at recounts, different settings and characters to further extend their creative writing skills.

Topic

Our major focus will be on the Tudor Era. Children will be learning about Monarchs, significant events, types of living and how children lived in this period. In geography children will be learning to read a compass and movement using degrees. They will also be looking at the water cycle and linking this to their science.

Physical Education

In P.E. we will be improving our fitness, developing our skills with large balls using our hands and developing netball skills. The children will improve their tactical skills of attacking and defending as a team. We will also be covering dance.

Mathematics

We will begin our term securing the pupils' knowledge of place value up to 10000, using negative numbers, multiplying and dividing mentally and improving their written calculations in addition and subtraction. They will also be improving their skills of measure using length, area, mass and volume. Pupils will further develop their reasoning skills.

Science

Identify how sound travels, differences in pitch and volume and patterns that sound creates. Identify the physical properties of liquid, solids, and gases. Explore those materials can exist in different states and that these can sometimes change. Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and the link between temperature and rate of evaporation. Develop observational skills to measure and record changes in states and temperature. Working scientifically.
