English

In English, we will be looking at the 'Little Red Hen' and character description through our 'Talk for Writing' approach. We will be exploring a range of texts and discussing the characters within these. Later in the term, we will focus on non-fiction writing. The children will continue to work on their personal writing targets.

Geography

We will be using our observational skills to discuss Hereford, Herefordshire, and the UK. We will also begin to discuss the features of a city, town, and village and the difference between them. The children will also deepen their understanding of the countries that make up the UK.

Mathematics

This term we are focusing on addition and subtraction within 20. We will also consolidate our knowledge of place value, now looking at the numbers up to 50. We will also be looking length and height, and weight and volume through practical lessons.

Year 1 Spring 2022

Year 1 have an exciting term ahead! Our topic this term is 'Hereford and the UK'. As part of this topic, we will be looking into our local area. We will continue to observe seasonal change and we will identify signs of spring. Later this term, we will be going swimming and starting our first Forest School sessions of Year 1.

PSHE

During this term the children will be focusing on 'Aims and Goals' and 'Healthy Me'. We will continue to work with Jigsaw Jack to explore these ideas

Art and Design

In DT, we will be designing and making our own pizzas. We will also continue to develop our Art skills and knowledge. We will create our own still life paintings of flowers.

Religious Education

This term in R.E we are looking at 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?' We will explore the religion of Judaism, through looking at artefacts, festivals and traditions.

Computing

Year 1 will be looking into how we can create digital content in different forms. We will talk about the different apps we can use to create digital content and we will make a rocket! Later in the term, we will also be using BeeBots to think about programming.

Physical Education

During this term, the children will be developing their dance skills. In dance, we will learn to keep the beat, create dance moves and travel effectively. We will also be learning about team games, and we will focus on, attack and defence and strategy in team games.
