

PSHE

This term we will be focusing on keeping ourselves healthy. We will do this by investigating the importance of healthy relationships and consider the benefits to a healthy balanced diet.

Science

In science this term we will be investigating the habitat of animals and be considering how they can be classified based upon similarities and differences in their characteristics and diet. We will also discuss the impacts humans have on our natural environment around the world.

Computing

We will be using iPads to develop filming and editing video skills through the storyboarding and creation of book trailers.

Religious Education

This term in R.E, Year 3 will be exploring the question: What kind of world did Jesus want? Children will be looking deeply into the word 'Gospel' and will be pondering on the links between the first disciples and how Christians live today as well as the importance of love and life. We will finish the term studying how and why people try to make the world a better place.

Geography

We will begin the term by learning about the Mediterranean and consider its natural and physical features by comparing it to where we live. We will also investigate why it makes such a wonderful holiday destination! Later in the term, will learn about our local area and the river and mountains of the United kingdom.

Music

Pupils will be studying musical notation, including crotchets and quavers before creating their own pieces. We are then looking forward to our Music week in Summer 2!

Languages

In Spanish this term we will continue to develop our vocabulary by learning and writing the date in Spanish. We will also be learning a familiar song and performing it off by heart

English

Our English lessons will continue to build on our story writing skills focusing on character description and suspense. We will be developing our vocabulary and considering the importance of using a variety of sentence starters in our writing. Spellings will continue to be taught on a weekly basis. Our new class text for Reading will be The Girl with the Broken Wing and The Water Horse.

Physical Education

In athletics, pupils will develop basic running, jumping and throwing techniques. They will be set challenges for distance and time that involve using different styles and combinations of running, jumping and throwing. Pupils will be thinking about how to achieve their greatest possible speed, distance or accuracy and learn how to persevere. Pupils will also be learning the game of rounders – developing their throwing, catching, striking and fielding skills. Pupils will be identifying how to score points and use strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition.

History

Year 3 will be continuing their travel back in time by exploring the world of the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings. They will discover how life changed in Britain after the Romans left

Art

The children will explore the works of the artist Robert Delaunay by investigating tones and shades of colour. We will explore modern abstract using shapes to create their own Delaunay inspired masterpiece.

At the beginning of this term we will be learning all about fractions, including adding and subtracting fractions and finding equivalent fractions.
