

History

Our History focus is on the Tudors. The children will be asking themselves the 'Big Question: What changes did the Tudors make to have a lasting effect on the society we see today?'. Through this question we shall explore the effects the Tudors had on religion, the monarchy structure and female empowerment and how those changes have had a lasting effect on the society we see today.

Geography

In Geography, after half term, we will be investigating rivers and understanding the key features and their locations.

R.E.

This term the children will explore Hinduism and the different ways they worship across the world and in Britain in particular.

Physical Education

In P.E. we will be working on our ball handling skills through the sport of tag rugby. After half term the children will be focusing on game based netball skills and applying these skills in game situations.

MFL

In Spanish, the children will be continuing to expand their vocabulary. We will start the year learning the vocabulary for the days of the week, months of the year and how to say the date and their birthdays.

Science

In Science, the children will investigate and work scientifically to understand magnetic forces, how to classify and describe speed, movements and directional changes. They will also be looking at sound, identify how sound travels, differences in pitch and volume and patterns that sound creates. Develop observational skills to measure and record changes in states and temperature. Working scientifically.

PSHE

The children will develop their understanding of families, friendships and respecting themselves and others, whilst maintaining safe relationships.

Maths

We will begin our term securing the pupils' knowledge of place value up to 10000, using negative numbers, multiplying and dividing mentally and improving their written calculations in addition and subtraction. They will also be improving their skills of measure using length, area, mass and volume. Pupils will further develop their reasoning skills.

English

This term in our English we will be starting by writing 'Adventure Stories' with a grammar focus on fronted adverbials and time conjunctions. We shall then be looking at how to write Diary entries, this will link with our History topic writing from perspectives of people from the Tudor time period.

Music

The children will be learning to listen to changes of pitch, tempo and dynamics

Computing

The children will be focusing on what it means to be safe online and how to achieve this.
