

Communication and Language

The children will be encouraged to join in with circle times as they talk about themes such as their likes and dislikes and what makes them special. There will be lots of emphasis on listening to stories and sharing books. The children will re-tell and make up their own stories using puppets, props and costumes.

Physical Development

Small equipment such as pegboards, threading, dough gym, scissors and pencil control activities will be used to develop the children's fine motor skills. During PE we will be improving the children's throwing and catching skills using balls, bean bags, etc. We will also be looking at how we can stay healthy in our PSED lessons.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will draw, paint and make collage pictures of themselves and their families. They will develop their imagination and role play skills through small world and puppet play. They will learn Nursery Rhymes, songs about Harvest and Christmas. They will have opportunities to explore the sounds they can make with different instruments.

Mathematics

Throughout this term we will be developing the children's ability to count, recognise and order numbers to 10 and beyond. We will also be introducing the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting through practical activities and discussions. The children will develop an interest in the names of shapes, their characteristics and sizes as they use shapes to make pictures and models.

RECEPTION Autumn 2024

Our topics this term are

'Marvellous Me'

and

'People Who Help Us'

The children will have opportunities to learn through experiences. We will meet lots of people who help us in our lives.

Understanding the World

The children will be encouraged to share their family experiences with the class during circle times. The children will explore similarities and differences in relation to each other and their families and what makes them unique. We will celebrate birthdays, Harvest and Christmas. The children will investigate and develop their IT skills using iPads, listening centre and interactive panels. The children will develop an understanding of different cultures and religions.

Literacy

Daily sharing and reading of quality story books such as 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Paper Dolls' and 'The Christmas Story'. We will also have a daily phonics session, following Oxford Reading Tree's 'Floppy's Phonics' programme. The children will be encouraged to put meaning to the marks they make as they draw, write and paint. As well as writing their names and some other simple familiar words, if ready.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

At the start of term, the emphasis will be on encouraging the children to play together and to develop friendships. They will be helped to settle into the daily routines and supported to become happy and confident in their new class. The children will be encouraged to express their feelings and to respect the feelings of the other children and adults.

How you can help

Share books and stories regularly and ask your child questions about what you have read. Help your child learn their sounds and tricky words when these are sent home. Practise writing their name, showing them the correct letter formation. Help your child learn to count, recognise and order numbers to ten and beyond.
