#### Mathematics

During this term we will be gocusing on multiplication and division, gractions, position and direction, halving and encouraging children to recall these gacts. We will develop our understanding og shapes and look at how we can apply this knowledge in diggerent contexts. We will also be using arrays to develop our knowledge og repeated addition and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will reason using our addition and subtraction skills with diggerent activities.

# Geography

We will compare our previous work on the UK with Australia, including comparing weather patterns. Also, we will look at regional glags and discuss their symbolic meaning.

#### **PSHE**

In PSHE, we will be continuing to Gollow our Jigsaw programme. This term, we will look into 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me.

#### Music

We will continue to develop our knowledge of pitch and tempo through a topic on superheroes.

### DT & Art
