

## Maths

We will be learning lots of different aspects of Maths, including statistics, shape, geometry, decimals, converting units and measurement. Alongside this, we will continue to focus on basic skills sessions as well as times table revision.

## English

We will begin the term by exploring warning tales using cautionary language to create our very own out of this world, Sci-Fi story. Later in the term, we will be writing instructions, linked to our DT project.

## History

Children will study famous historical people, buildings and events of Herefordshire and how several aspects of national history are reflected in the locality.

We will be studying the life and achievements of Ancient Greeks, and their influence on the western world.

## Spanish

Children will engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others through studying and describing family and friends in Spanish.

## Computing

Children will be explaining what musical theatre is. They will categorise songs as action songs or character songs and select appropriate music to tell the story of a journey. Finally, children will perform with their groups, ensuring smooth transitions between spoken dialogue, singing and dancing.

## Ancient Greece

## Art / DT

In DT, children will research healthy food options and create their own healthy recipe. Hopefully, children will have the opportunity to visit a local restaurant to experience the production process.

Our Art unit focuses on architecture, guiding pupils through observational drawing, printmaking, and building design. They will analyse Hundertwasser's work, enhancing their understanding of composition.

## Science

Throughout the Summer term, the children will research and study the life cycles of plants, animals and humans. The children will recognise the differences between mammals, amphibians insects and birds and describe the changes they go through.

## Physical Education

This term children will develop their speed, endurance and coordination in athletics through running, jumping and throwing. In tennis, they will improve racket control, footwork and accuracy. Through practice and games they'll build confidence and teamwork skills.

## RE / PSHE

In RE, children will acknowledge how Christians believe they should live by following the example of Jesus, before moving on to what matters most to Humanists. In PSHE, we will focus on relationships, building on our social and emotional skills as well as understanding versions of ourselves and our changing bodies.
