

Maths

This term we will turn our focus to fractions, decimals, time, money, shape and position. There will be a continual emphasis on developing our reasoning skills. We will also be continuing to work towards our MTC checker in June by continuing to practice our times tables.

English

The children will continue to develop their spelling, punctuation, grammar and handwriting skills. The children's main focus will be narrative writing. The children will be focusing on myths and quests, explanation texts and poetry.

Physical Education

This term the children will be focussing on tennis and athletics. They will learn to use and apply the skills of tennis into match situations. In athletics they will focus on the core skills for running and throwing in order to put them into practice in competitive events.

Computing

In Computing, pupils will finish their learning on online safety before moving on to develop their computational thinking skills, including problem-solving, pattern recognition, and creating simple algorithms.

Music

The children will be learning about changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics with help of our River based theme.

R.E.

The children will be focusing on the 'journey of life' embedding ideologies and viewpoints from all different religions such as Hinduism, Judaism and Christianity.

MFL

In Spanish, the children will be learning to identify animal names, and recognise noun genders. They will select appropriate adjective and characteristics, make plausible predictions about stories, and adapt sentences to create their own narratives.

Science

The children will investigate and work scientifically to understand forces, specifically magnetic forces, how to classify and describe speed, movements and directional changes

History/Geography

In history, the children will be answering the question 'How did Britain change after the Anglo-Saxon invasion?'. Whilst explaining how the Britons felt when the Romans left Britain and suggesting reasons for Anglo-Saxon invasion of Britain. Geography will see the children explore the question, 'What are rivers and how are they used?' and provide opportunities to describe the physical features, name the three courses, list problems and name some major rivers and their locations.

Art & D&T

In our art in the first half term, we will be creating some fabric art taking inspiration from the different patterns of nature.

In the second half of the term, we will be doing D&T. Our focus will be on cooking and nutrition whereby the children will be adapting a recipe. Time will be spent on looking at: preparation, budgeting, packaging, testing and evaluation.

PSHE

This term, Year 4 pupils will learn about staying safe, including online safety and identifying trusted adults, as well as understanding how their bodies change in an age-appropriate way. In the second half of the term, they will focus on Citizenship, exploring rights and responsibilities, respect for others, and how to be active members of their community..
